APPROVED WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

Stall Waste

All vendors are to be responsible for any waste that their stall generates. This includes any sample utensils, takeaway containers and green waste. The stallholder is responsible for making provision for having the empty vessels returned to them and then responsible for the disposal of that waste after the market.

All stallholders should wherever possible use packaging that is biodegradable or recyclable.


Plastic carry away shopping bags are not permitted for use except for plants and patrons are required to bring their own shopping baskets.

Vendors are also required to respect and care for the Richmond Village Green and Hall area and ensure that their stall site and the area that surrounds it, is left in a clean and tidy state once the market closes.

General Public Waste

Council will provide 2 additional litter bins in the area for use by the general public at the market with one bin for recyclable material and the other for non-recyclable waste material.

The bins will be lined and the waste removed by Council's Contractor as a part of the routine public litter bin collections.
